

God's Holy Day Release Form

Members and associates of The Assembly of Eloah are adherents to all of the Renewed Covenant obligations in our worship of the One True God (*John 17:3; Revelation 19:10*), who is our Father (*1Peter 1:3; James 1:27; Colossians 3:17; Ephesians 4:6*) and whom we only are to serve (*Matthew 4:10; 1Thessalonians 1:9*) by the Holy Spirit (*Philippians 3:3*).

We are required to appear before God three times annually (*Exodus 23:14; 34:23*). This is for eight days at the Feast of Unleavened Bread, which includes the Lord's Supper/Passover/Wave Sheaf offering and the Feast of Weeks or Pentecost (Saturday and Sunday); and for eight days at the Feast of Tabernacles and Last Great Day (*Leviticus 23:1-44; Deuteronomy 16:1-16; Colossian 2:16*).

These three Feasts have five Holy Days or convocations, which are commanded assemblies (*Leviticus 23, Deuteronomy 16, Numbers 28 & 29*). These Feasts were observed by Jesus Christ during the Temple period (*John 2:23*) and he will keep them once again on his return in the future (*Luke 22:16*). These Feasts were observed by the Apostles and the early covenant keeping Christian Church (*1Corinthians 5:8*). They were and we are, the sacrificial living stones (*1Peter 2:4-10*) of the Temple of God (*1Corinthians 6:19*) the Body of Christ (*1Corinthians 12:27*) which is the Church of God or The Assembly of Eloah (*Colossians 1:24*).

Annually, we keep set apart or Holy the weekly seventh day, which is from Friday evening at dark to Saturday evening at dark, and the monthly lunar New Moons at the conjunction as required Holy Day convocations which are commanded assemblies (*Exodus 20:8-11; Deuteronomy 5:12-15; Hebrews 4:9-11 & Hosea 2:11; Amos 8:5; Isaiah. 66:23; Ezekiel 45:17, 46:1-6; Colossians 2:16*). The days are kept Holy, meaning set apart for a specific purpose and separated from our business affairs from dark (End of Evening Nautical Twilight) to dark (*Genesis. 1:5; Psalm 104:20; Leviticus 23:23, Acts 27:27-33; Nehemiah 13:19*).

Please excuse _____ from school or employment so that he/she may participate in these commanded and spiritually Renewed Covenant assemblies.
