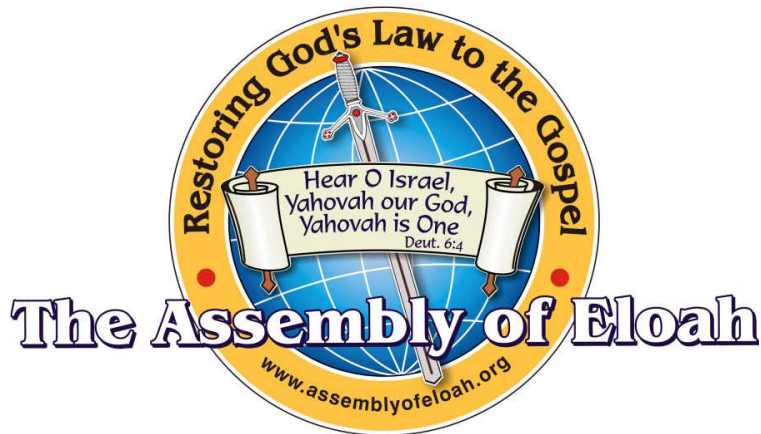
The Purpose of Life
